## GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS / AUTHORS

Editor, Global Evolution\*

GLOBAL EVOLUTION- The half yearly journal of Teacher Education and Management, Published by Ramanujan Educational Institutions, Haryana invites original, research based papers, articles, book reviews and case studies on topics of current concern in all areas of Management and Teacher Education. The selection of papers / articles would be based on their relevance, clarity, topicality and originality, the extent to which they advance knowledge, understanding and application and their likely contribution towards inspiring future development and research. Research papers/articles are selected through blind-refereed review by subject experts.

While sending contributions, the following guidelines must be strictly followed. Contributions that do not adhere to the guidelines will not be considered.

- 1) Papers should be reader friendly and written in clear, straight forward language, avoiding too many jargons and technical terms. There should however be no compromise on rigour or analysis.
- 2) GLOBAL EVOLUTION aims to maintain a balance between purely research-oriented papers and those derived mainly from the experiences of practitioners involved in the different areas of management. In the case of research-based articles, the managerial / policy implications of the research / study should be highlighted towards the end of the paper.
- 3) Manuscript should not generally **exceed 6500 words**. The paper/article should be typed on one side of A4 size paper using **Times New Roman with font size 12**. There should be **1.5 lines spacing** with one inch margin on top and bottom & 0.7" & 0.5" on left and right sides respectively. All pages should be numbered starting from 01 & text aligned as justify. The paragraph spacing should be equal to font size. The manuscript should be accompanied by an **abstract (not more than 200 words)** of the paper / article and introduction of authors (name/s, designation/s, affiliation/s) should be given on separate sheets. **The entire article should be in II columns design** with 0.2" center spacing. Authors / contributors are requested to preferably use **MS Word** for writing the papers / articles. Initially, soft copy of the research paper /article can be sent through email. Thereafter, one copy of the printout, along with duly signed declaration, should be sent to the Editor indicating author(s) name and title of the paper. The hard copy and electronic copy must match exactly. Papers / articles submitted should be accompanied by a declaration by the contributors / authors that these have not been published elsewhere or submitted for publication elsewhere. Editorial decision regarding articles accepted for publishing in the journal will be conveyed in around three months time.
- 4) The research paper/article should contain the following items, preferably in the order shown below:
  - a) Title, author's affiliation and complete address. (**Title font size -14; bold & Uppercase, Author's name font size - 12 Bold, Affiliation font size - 11, all center aligned**)
  - b) Abstract (not more than 200 words) outlining the purpose, scope and conclusions of the paper. The abstract should explain importance/significance of the results/study. (**Font size -12**)
  - c) The text, suitably divided under **HEADINGS (Font size -12, Bold and Uppercase)** and **Sub-Headings (Font size -12, Bold, Title Case)** to explain the text and to emphasize points.
  - d) Acknowledgements, if any. (**Font size -11**)
  - e) **References:** Only such references; which are actually used in the text, should be given in the reference list. In the text, references should be cited with the surname of the author(s) along with the year of publication, in brackets. References should be complete in all respects and should be alphabetically arranged. (**Font size-11**)
  - f) **Tables:** Tables should be numbered consecutively in roman numerals and should be appropriately referred to in the text as Table 1, Table 2 etc. **Table Title should be written on top of the table with font size 11 bold & center aligned.** Wherever necessary the source should be indicated at the bottom of the chart / table. **Endnotes, italics and quotation marks** should be kept to the minimum
  - g) **Graphs:** The minimum amount of descriptive text should be used on graphs and drawings. Graph axes should be labeled with variable written out in full, along the length of the axes, with the unit in parenthesis. Graphs should be numbered consecutively. Title should be

written at the bottom of the graphs in **Font size-11, Bold & Center aligned**.

- h) **Figures and Illustrations:** Title should be written at the bottom of the figures / picture in **Font size-11, Bold & Center aligned**.
- 5) The book review should normally not **exceed more than 1500 words**. It covers abstract on new and important books on Management and Teacher Education.

- The purpose and prospective readers for whom the paper has been targeted, the significance / contribution of the paper / article.
- Appropriate context and background to the paper / article by referring to earlier work in the area.
- Practicality and usefulness of the work.
- Implications of the study and identification of future areas of work.
- Proper structuring of the paper so that it reads in a clear and logical manner.

**COPYRIGHT:**

The manuscript must have not appeared in another publication. This will ensure copyright protection for both the authors and Ramanujan Educational Institutions, Haryana. It is the author's /contributor's responsibility to obtain necessary permission to reprint / reproduce / re-use long quotations, tables, figures or graphs previously published earlier with copyright restrictions Papers/articles published in the GLOBAL EVOLUTION should not be reproduced / reprinted in any manner without prior written permission of the Editor.

**REVIEW PROCESS:**

Research papers/articles are selected through blind-refereed review by subject experts. GLOBAL EVOLUTION reserves the right of making editorial amendments in the final draft of the manuscript to suit the Journal's requirement.
