## Preface

The higher education sector in India is going through an exciting period with the government proposing a range of reforms.

With 54 % of the population below the age of 25, India is all set to reap the demographic dividends or head for a disaster depending upon how it educates its youth. This is both challenge and opportunity.

These reforms, if in synchronism with global standard education system, domestic industrial and society's needs may yield rich dividends, for private sector in particular and for the country, in general.
