

OUR ACHIEVEMENTS



- IMSEC has been rated as No.1 among all private engineering colleges in Uttar Pradesh and No.3 among all technical institutions in Uttar Pradesh, including IIT-Kanpur in a national survey conducted by CSR-GHRDC. The overall position on all India basis is 23rd among engineering colleges of excellence and 33rd among all colleges in India.
- IMSEC has been nominated as a CAT Examination (for admission to IIMS) centre for a period of two years by NIIT, India & Prometric Ltd, an International certifying agency. The exam is due to be held during the last week of November & first week of December.
- NAAC inspection has been conducted at IMSEC and the report was satisfactory.
- NBA accreditation initiative has also been taken by all the departments.

ACADEMIC INITIATIVES



- Regular assignments are being given on weekly basis on every Friday which is returned by the students by Tuesday of the next week. A decision in this regard has been taken by director sir.
- Appreciation Letter along with a cash prize of Rs 6000/- has been given to 29 faculty members whose result is 100% & average university marks in the subject are more than 55 %.
- A calendar for the current session has been released and made available.
- A bridge course has been started to remove the various deficiencies of the students who have come from a different back-ground or have made a lateral entry.
- Every Saturday has been declared as a working day for the first year students and faculty-members so that the syllabus gets completed timely and smoothly.

ADMINISTRATIVE INITIATIVES



- The biometric system of attendance is being run successfully. As a result the cases of late attendance have fallen off drastically. This has resulted substantial improvement attendance of faculty and staff. The earlier average of absentees was approx 12% a day which has now come down to as low as 2-3% a day.
- The remuneration for the accumulated ML and CL has been paid to the employees and now new leave rules have been implemented.
- 6th Pay Commission's recommendations have been implemented in IMSEC. This institute was the first in the region to implement the same.
- A quality policy has been decided for the recruitment of the faculty members. Special emphasis has been laid on the proper qualification and no one has been recruited below a master's degree.
- For faculty members, EPF benefits have been made available.
- In the recent recruitments, 3 Professors, 7 Asst. Professors, 17 Senior Lecturers and 10 Lecturers have been appointed.
